

LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

- a) Over any fence bounding the course.
- b) Over the line of white posts
 - i. by the Green-keepers' Shed on the 7th hole.
 - ii. through the hedge around the practice putting green.
 - iii. to the right and left of the 10th hole.
 - iv. in front of the 11th tee and to the left of the 10th green.
 - v. to the left of the 12th and 13th holes.
 - vi. extending from the end of the conifers between the 1st and 18th fairways to the edge of the 1st tee and onward to the end of the beech hedge by the practice putting green, when playing the 8th hole.
- c) On or over the road to the car park when playing the 8th hole.
- d) The car park and the overflow car park.
- e) On or over any man-made path directly adjacent to the Clubhouse and patio.

OUT OF BOUNDS FENCE LOWER 7TH GREEN

If a ball comes to rest on or against the OOB fence or the stance or intended swing is affected, the player may, under penalty of 1 stroke, obtain relief under Rule 28 or drop a ball in the Drop Zone provided.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- a) Tractor paths to the right of the 1st hole and left of the 8th hole.
- b) The white posts defining out of bounds as referred to in b) vi. (above) when playing the 1st, 11th or 18th holes.
- c) Drain plugs on greens.

MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

AREAS WHERE NO PLAY IS PERMITTED (Rule 25 - 1b Relief)

- a) Conservation areas defined by blue posts.
- b) Temporary greens not in use defined within a white line.
- c) Within the marked area behind the safety net on the Practice Ground when playing the 11th hole.

THE PRACTICE GROUND (between the 11th & 18th fairways and defined by closely mown grass)

If a ball comes to rest on the Practice Ground, play the ball as it lies or take a drop outside the closely mown area, within one club length from the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.

When winter rules are in play, a player is not permitted to lift, clean and place the ball within this area. The player must either:

- a) Play the ball as it lies.
- b) The ball may be cleaned and dropped within 1 club length from the nearest point of relief no nearer to the hole and outside the closely mown area defining the practice ground.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Are permitted under Rule 14-3 and Appendix iv-5.

BUNKERS AND RAKES

After filling in and smoothing over all holes and footprints, the player should leave the rake lying in the bunker.

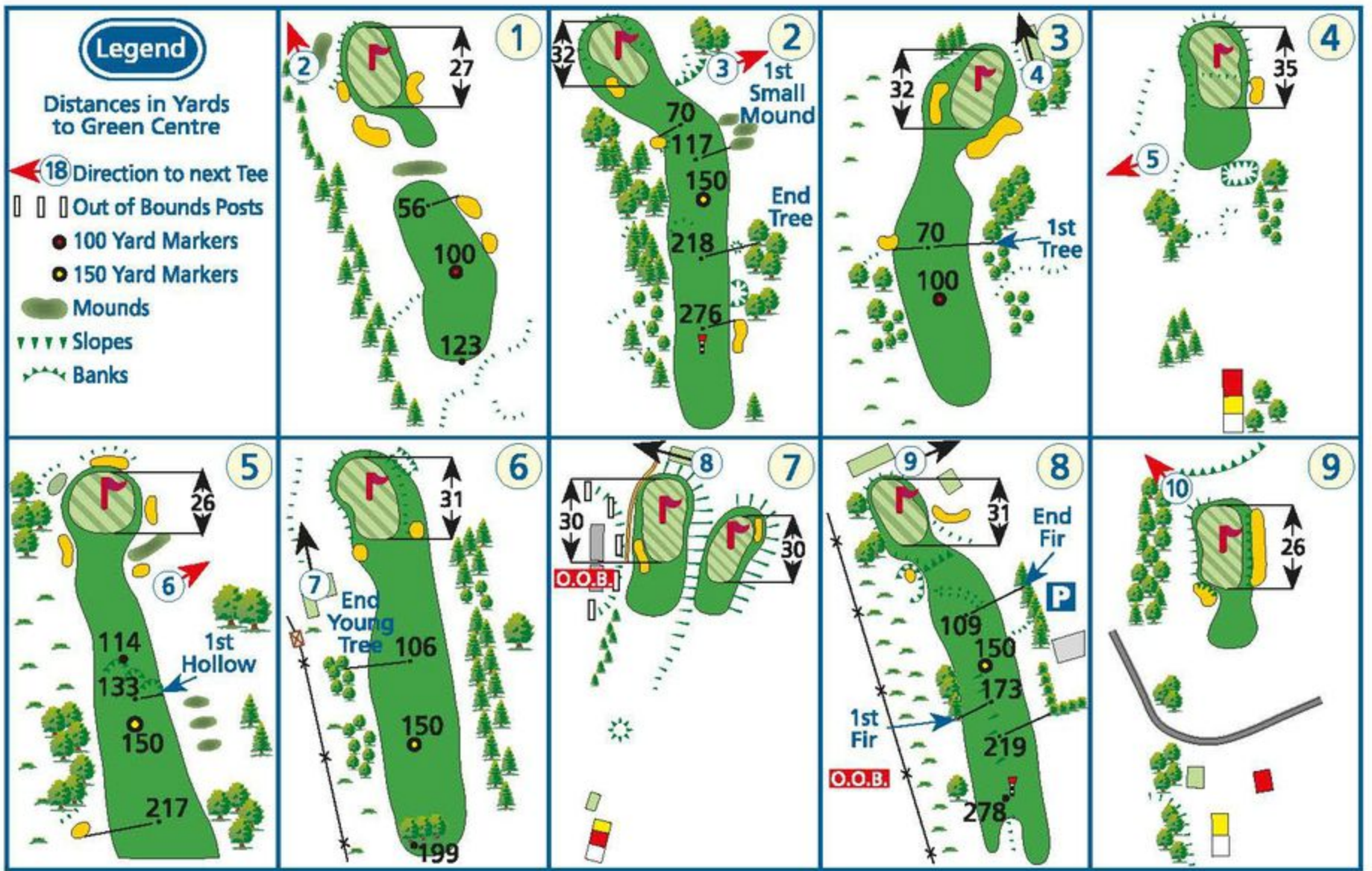
